For September, the mission spotlight is on **New Missions**. For over 30 years, New Missions has established local Christian churches, schools, clinics, and feeding stations in Haiti and the D. R. providing children with education, food, and medical care so they can grow strong and make an impact in their community. Their purpose is to "*share the message of man's redemption through Jesus Christ to all men, to establish and maintain a place of worship for Almighty God, our Heavenly Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son through the Holy Spirit, and to promote Christian fellowship and edification*". **This month, we are raising money to help pay for food and repairs to churches damaged by recent hurricanes.** The storms hammered Haiti and the D.R. and killed at least five people, dumping torrential rainfall and life-threatening flooding. With brown water up to their knees, some residents tried to save what they could from their flooded homes, while street traders saw their goods washed away. Storms pose a serious risk to Haiti and the D.R. every year. ***If you can contribute, please indicate "NM" besides Missions on the tithes and offerings envelope.***
